COURSE:English Language Development ACOURSE No.2105

**DESCRIPTION:** This course is designed for those students who have no literacy skills in their native language or who, are not familiar with the Roman alphabet system. This course assists in the acquisition of English basic language skills with emphasis on listening comprehension and oral production. This course is designed for students in the preproduction stages of language development. Listening comprehension and beginning oral production are emphasized. Course content is relevant to the student's life and focuses on general topics and on literacy. Basic non-verbal social customs and cultural aspects are taught through modeling.

STANDARDS/OBJECTIVES: Upon completion of this course the student will be able to:

- 1. Recognize, name and form letters of the alphabet (upper and lower case).
- 2. Produce basic personal information.
- 3. Initiate and respond to greetings.
- 4. Follow simple classroom instructions.
- 5. Recognize and name the days of the week and the months of the year.
- 6. Demonstrate an understanding of time and dates.
- 7. Demonstrate an understanding of and use of simple words, phrases and questions as represented in every day situations.
- 8. Demonstrate an understanding of and use of high frequency commands and courtesy expressions.
- 9. Know and be able to recite the alphabet accurately and count from 1 to 100.
- 10. Recognize common public signs and symbols.
- 11. Produce in writing basic personal identification and complete guided activities.
- 12. Respond to simple commands.
- 13. Respond to simple questions with yes / no or other appropriate verbal responses.
