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
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FALL 2009 RACIAL AND ETHNIC SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

The Fall 2009 Racial and Ethnic Survey report was compiled and published by the Orange County Department of Education. The report contains data extracted from the California Longitudinal Pupil Achievement Data System (CALPADS) filed by schools in Orange County to the California Department of Education (CDE). It also contains data extracted from DataQuest, the CDE developed and maintained system that provides reports on accountability, test scores, staffing, and student-level data.

Several changes have been made to the racial and ethnic categories used in the California Longitudinal Pupil Achievement Data System (CALPADS) reports for the Fall of 2009, based on new federal definitions:

- The previous Filipino category has been collapsed and is now added to the Asian category.
- Native Hawaiians are now identified and included in the Pacific Islander category.
- The previous Multiple or No Response category has now been separated into 2 separate categories.
- The previous No Response category is now called Missing.

For the purpose of this report, we have chosen to combine the Multiple and Missing categories to be consistent with the way data was reported in the previous year's Racial and Ethnic Survey. In some cases, year-over-year changes in race and ethnicity can be attributed to school districts re-surveying students using the latest federal definitions of the racial and ethnic categories.

County-wide enrollment declined from the prior year by 2,157 students or 0.43%. Even though the numbers of students have not significantly declined year over year, this is the lowest student enrollment Orange County has experienced since fiscal year 1998-99. The ethnic category with the greatest increase in the number of students enrolled was Hispanic, with an increase of 4.45% or 10,038 students. The ethnic category with the greatest decline in the number of enrolled students was White, with a decline of 4.59% or 7,600 students. The ethnic distribution of Orange County appears to be very similar to that of the State of California.

County-wide, Orange County had an increase of 4.90% or 1,633 graduating students from the prior year. The ethnic categories with the greatest increases in graduates were Hispanic, with an increase of 16.74% or 1,767 graduates, and Asian, with an increase of 8.48% or 504 graduates.

In previous years, dropout totals were calculated for grades 7 through 12. Beginning in 2008, dropout counts are only calculated for grades 9 through 12 in K-12 school districts (excluding county office programs) in order to be consistent with figures reported by the CDE. Other studies may be calculated with a different base.

Orange County had an increase of 154 dropouts in grades 9 – 12 from the prior year. Although the percentage of dropouts in Orange County increased from 1.2% to 1.3%, this figure is still significantly lower than the California statewide dropout percentage of 4.5%. Orange County districts saw the greatest increase in students dropping out in grades 11 and 12, which mirrors the trend being experienced statewide.









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


