**DESCRIPTION:** This course is designed to teach life skills through a competency-based model with emphasis on expanding English fluency and communication skills. Language functions and forms are integrated with informational sources, skills and topics, both general and vocational. Oral language is stressed while development of individual literacy skills of vocabulary building, reading, and writing is sought. Social customs are taught through modeling, positive and negative examples, and through controlled practice.

STANDARDS/OBJECTIVES: Upon completion of this course the student will be able to:

- 1. Demonstrate an understanding of simple words and phrases; asking and answering simple questions; make statements in the past, present and future tenses; communicate simple personal information; give and understand simple directions and instructions.
- 2. Respond appropriately to general directions.
- 3. Interpret isolated words and phrases in familiar contexts, interpret terms on simplified forms, and scan for numerical information.
- 4. Read and demonstrate an understanding of short, simple narrative paragraphs on familiar topics and produce answers to simple questions and short passages.
- 5. Demonstrate proficiency in writing skills by completing communications tasks such as filling our sample forms and applications.
