

HiSET® courses are designed to ensure that students pass all sections of the test:

Writing- 60 questions + essay {2 hours}
Science- 60 questions {1 hour, 20 minutes}
Math- 55 questions {1 hour, 30 minutes}
Social Studies- 60 questions {1 hour, 10 minutes}
Reading- 50 questions {1 hour, 5 minutes-English}
{1 hour, 20 minutes-Spanish}





How to Register

Registration is <u>limited to 16 adults</u> each testing date. Space permitting, you must register in person at least two business days prior to the test date.

To register, you must appear <u>in person</u> and bring the following:

- © Completed forms-can be obtained from the OCDE website: www.ocde.us {search HiSET®} or in our office.
- **Test Fees: \$150 money order payable to the Orange County Department of Education <u>or</u> \$30 per section.
- **Retest Fee: \$30 money order payable to the Orange County Department of Education for <u>each</u> retest.
- Flease have your HiSET® ETS number ready when you come for in person registration-YOU CANNOT BE REGISTERED WITHOUT THIS NUMBER.
- Government issued photo ID (please see facts column)
- All money orders must be recent
- Fees are non-transferable and non-refundable
- *Please note the name & birthday on your ID MUST match the name on your HiSET® profile EXACTLY. *

Eligibility

To take the HiSET® exam, you must be:

- **18 years or older, or within 60 days of your 18th birthday
- Tou must be a California resident & show proof of residency

FACTS

Q-What is the cost for the HiSET® exam?

A-\$150 for the complete test, \$30 for <u>each</u> retest or subtest purchased if not purchasing the entire battery at once. Money order made out to the Orange County Department of Education is the <u>only</u> type of payment accepted.

Q-What is acceptable ID?

A-CA driver's license or ID from DMV, military card,

passport with California residency, Mexican Consulate card, Indian tribal card. ID MUST BE CURRENT, expired ID's will not be accepted. **You must present a government issued ID**. Additional documentation may be required.

Q-How many times may I retest?

A-You may test a total of three times per subject, per calendar year {January- December}.

Q-How will I know if I passed the test?

A-Examinees who pass will be sent the High School Equivalency Certificate to their registered email & registered home address within 4-6 weeks of completing the test. You can check your score online with your ETS ID and print out your transcripts at any time. Scores are typically available on your HiSET® profile within one week of testing. Please visit https://www.parchment.com/ for certificate questions and information.

Q-What score do I need to pass the test?

A-To pass the HiSET® exam, you must receive a standard score of at least $\underline{8}$ on $\underline{\textbf{each}}$ of the five subtests $\underline{\textbf{AND}}$ earn an average standard score of $\underline{\textbf{45}}$ or higher.

Q- What if I'm going to be late or can't make it?

A-Late arrivals will not be admitted. Your fee will be forfeited in full unless you notify the testing center TWO business days prior to your scheduled testing date. Please see registration paperwork for specifics.
