1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

College and Career Preparatory Academy is a charter operated by the Orange County Department of Education serving as an alternative education program for students from the 28 districts within Orange County who did not complete high school and are working into adulthood to earn their diploma. At College and Career Preparatory Academy, they are given the technology and materials needed to work at their own pace virtually, and have the opportunity to complete coursework, grow personal agency, and earn their diploma once their credits are completed. During their time in College and Career Preparatory Academy, students did not complete arts elective coursework during the 2023-24 school year. College and Career Preparatory Academy began planning arts opportunities for the 2024-25 school year, including hiring itinerant staff and engaging community partners to offer arts for students. Students will be surveyed by staff to determine their interest levels and will be given the opportunity to sign up for the arts programs they desire.
