

Power Point 2007 allows you to animate Smart Art one piece at a time. For example, you can you can make pieces of a diagram “fly in” individually rather than all at once. Just follow these steps:

1. Insert the Smart Art diagram of interest, and enter text as you would like it to appear in the presentation
  - a. Right-click on the Smart Art frame and go to Group > Ungroup
  - b. This removes the Smart Art frame. The diagram is now a single grouped object
2. Right click anywhere on the grouped object and go to Group > Ungroup. All pieces are now independent objects that you can animate one at a time
3. To animate each individual object, click the object and then select the animation tab
  - a. In the animations group, click on the Animate drop down box to select the animation effect of interest
  - b. Repeat step 3 for all objects you want to animate.
