

In PowerPoint 2007, you can hide your background graphics on individual slides without changing your master slides or covering-up unwanted graphics with text boxes. This allows you to use different backgrounds within one presentation.

1. In PowerPoint 2007, open your presentation.
2. In **Normal View** or **Slide Sorter View**, click on the slide with the background you would like to hide.
3. On the menu ribbon, click on the **Design** tab
  - a. In the **Background** pane, click the box next to **“hide background graphics.”**
  - b. The background graphics on that slide will be hidden.
4. You are now free to add whatever design you want to this slide.
