# **BOARD MEMBER - 4TM DISTRICT VACANCY**

## **ESTENDED FINAL FILING DATE**: Friday, December 17, 2021 **NEW PROVISIONAL APPOINTMENT DATE**: December 21, 2021

Tim Shaw representing the 4<sup>th</sup> District, has resigned from the Orange County Board of Education effective November 1, 2021. A successor will be provisionally appointed by the Orange County Board of Education to complete his term which expires June 30, 2022. The outcome of the June 7, 2022 election will determine the final two years of the 4<sup>th</sup> District.

#### Description:

The primary functions of the Orange County Board of Education (OCBE) are to review and adopt the annual budget of the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE), review and approve the interim financial reports, approve charter schools on appeal or approve innovative new county wide charters, take action to real property transactions for the OCDE, hold hearings and make final judgment on interdistrict appeals regarding a student expulsion or interdistrict attendance request, adopt rules andregulations for the Orange County Board of Education, advance learning and achievement for all students, and support the local school districts. The 4<sup>th</sup> Trustee district currently serves the cities and communities of Buena Park, Fullerton, La Habra, Placentia, and portions of Anaheim in the current districts. The fourth district will redrawn and/or renumbered secondary to 2021 census. The finalized map will be completed by December 15, 2021.

## Minimum Requirements:

- A legal resident of the 4<sup>th</sup> OCDE Trustee Area, County of Orange.
- A registered voter in County of Orange at the time of appointment. No member of the OCDE staff, or any employee of a school district is eligible to serve on the Board (California Education Code 1006).

#### Application and Selection Procedure:

Candidates need to submit a resume and notice of intention to be provisionally appointed by the OCBE to <u>ocbe@ocde.us.</u> no later than 12:00 PM, Friday, December 17, 2021. All resumes and letters need to be on file by the deadline date. Such documents will be public information and available for review during normal business hours at OCDE which is located at 200 Kalmus, Drive, Costa Mesa, CA 92628.

Letters of intent and resumes will be reviewed by the Executive Committee of the Orange County Board of Education. Those candidates successfully completing the initial screening process will be invited for an interview. The Board will interview the identified candidates in public on December 21, 2021. The provisional appointment term for the successful candidate is from December 21, 2021 to June 30, 2022.
