- Enrollment and Graduation Data for 2022-23
 - 41 graduates, 125 new enrollments (as of 7/1), and there are currently 144 students enrolled
- CalWorks Grant
 - \$56,455 (2021-22 allocation), funding Community Resource Specialist as well as students:
 - Dress for Success for CAJC Graduates
 - Open House at Anaheim

- Drivers ed simulators; State Rep. Blake Archeletta made in-person DMV appts for students to take drivers tests
 - Creation of Food Pantry
 - \$xxxx - allocation decreased in 2022-23, funds will support our new student pantry
- LCAP Updates
 - The 2021-24 LCAP was approved on 6/15/22 unanimously by the Orange County Board of Education, \$644,177 total allocation
