

**DESCRIPTION OF THE PETITION TO TRANSFER TERRITORY FROM
SADDLEBACK VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO CAPISTRANO UNIFIED
SCHOOL DISTRICT – LOMAS LAGUNA HOA**

Education Code section 35705.5 requires the Orange County Committee on School District Organization to make available to the public and to the governing boards affected by the petition a description of the petition, including all of the following:

(1) The rights of the employees in the affected districts to continued employment.

Not applicable to the Lomas Laguna HOA Petition. The rights of the employees in the affected school districts to continued employment will not be affected by the proposed territory transfer.

(2) The local control funding formula allocation pursuant to Section 42238.02, as implemented by Section 42238.03, per pupil, for each affected district and the effect of the petition, if approved, on that allocation.

(3) Whether the school districts involved will be governed, in part, by provisions of a city charter and, if so, in what way.

Not applicable to the Lomas Laguna HOA Petition. Neither of the affected school districts are governed by a city charter.

(4) Whether the governing boards of any proposed new district will have five or seven members.

Not applicable to the Lomas Laguna HOA Petition. The Petition does not propose the creation of any new school districts.

(5) A description of the territory or school districts in which the election, if any, will be held.

If the petition is approved, the County Committee shall notify the Orange County Superintendent of Schools, who shall call an election in the territory of the affected districts, as determined by the County Committee, to be conducted at the next election of any kind, in accordance with Education Code section 35710. The County Committee will determine the election territory at a public meeting if the petition is approved.

(6) Where the proposal is to create two or more new districts, whether the proposal will be voted on as a single proposition.

Not applicable to the Lomas Laguna HOA Petition. The Petition does not propose the creation of any new school districts.

(7) Whether the governing board of any new district will have trustee areas and, if so, whether the trustees will be elected by only the voters of that trustee area or by the voters of the entire school district.

Not applicable to the Lomas Laguna HOA Petition. The Petition does not propose the creation of any new school districts.

(8) A description of how the property, obligations, and bonded indebtedness of original districts will be divided.

The SVUSD Measure B Bond balance is currently \$74,370,000 outstanding; the obligation is set to be paid off in 2030. The Saddleback Valley Unified School District is in the process of determining how the petitioned area proportionate share would be allocated throughout the school district.

(9) A description of when the first governing board of any new district will be elected and how the terms of office for each new trustee will be determined.
