

# **TESTING**

Academic state testing is coming up after Spring Break. There are two types of tests, the traditional STAR test and the newer Smarter Balanced test (SBAC). The following information may help you in planning for these assessments:

#### STAR SCIENCE TEST

Grades 5 and 8 only Thursday, April 7 Time: 9:30 a.m. – 12:00 noon The STAR is a traditional paper-pencil test (fill in the bubble) for all 5th and 8th grade CHEP students. Test will be given at CHEP West.

#### SBAC Test

Grades 3 – 8
April 25, 26, 28 for all 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> graders.
The Smarter Balanced Test assesses Math and English Language Arts. SBAC is for all 3rd through 8th grade CHEP students. Each topic has two subtests, a Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) and a Performance Task (PT), totaling four subtests in all. To get a complete assessment summary sent to you, your child must take all of the tests. Watch for a letter with information regarding testing. The location for this year's SBAC testing is the OCDE main campus.
