### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

## FROM THE DESK OF OUR PRINCIPAL, JANE DONEY

The year is winding down and what a whirlwind these last weeks have been! "Character Matters", Peter Pan, EXPO, our Choir and Band Spring Concert, classes and other events going on....each one providing fun experiences and building memories for our students!

We are now gearing up for the Smarter Balanced Field Test. This online test takes the place of the STAR ELA and Math tests from previous years. Because it is a field test, students have the opportunity this year to "test the test." There will be no student, school or district results. It is designed to help the state calibrate the test (before it



"counts") and to provide students an opportunity to practice with the new test delivery system, without any penalty. Please note, if you have a 5th and/or 8th grader, they will also be taking **Balanced** the paper-and-pencil STAR Science test, which will provide results. Be sure to let your CHEP teacher know if you have any questions.

On a much different note, I wanted to address a significant change that will be occurring over the summer. CHEP, like all other schools, must continually look at our budget and consider the very best uses of our resources. In doing so, the decision has been made to merge CHEP South with CHEP Central (at the Central location) due to our declining student enrollment in South County. This decision is one that has been discussed administratively for years and the time has now come to make this shift. The Central families and teachers are excited to welcome CHEP South families and staff, Alyne Cronin, Peg Broyles, Cheryl Taylor, Julie Neiswonger, and Cindy Williams, to the new blended site. CHEP teacher, Julie Ames, will be joining CHEP West, where there is great growth in student numbers, as well. While change can certainly be challenging, it also provides opportunities. The collaboration and community building between the sites presents

opportunity for more friendships, more support, and excellent

use of our resources so that CHEP can continue to provide

wonderful classes, workshops and events.






