# FROM THE DESK OF OUR PRINCIPAL, JANE DONEY

This year is flying by! I hope you all had a wonderfulsystem and asks different types of questions.holiday season with family and friends, making memories!If you have not done so yet, please go to the Smarter



As we look forward to the new year, there are some changes that I want to be sure you are aware of related to state testing. As a

public school that receives state funding, we are required to participate in standardized testing for accountability purposes. In the past, these tests have been known as the Standardized Testing and Reporting program, or STAR. These multiple choice, "bubble" tests have been a part of the state educational system since 1998.

With the introduction of the new Common Core State Standards, we will be implementing a new testing system this year, called Smarter Balanced. Among the biggest changes is that it will be online! As you can imagine, this is quite a big shift, because it not only means there will be a new test, but that we as a school need to determine a plan for assessing our students in our compute labs over the six week window that we have been assigned. Another change is that 2nd grade will no longer be tested. Smarter Balanced is given in grades 3-8 and 11. We will be sending out letters with specific test date information as soon as we have all the details and have a comprehensive plan in place.

This year is a "test pilot" year, meaning that the students will be taking a test in both English-Language Arts and Mathematics, but they will not receive any test results. This is for a few reasons. First, the state recognizes that schools need to see how their technology will hold up during the testing and also there is acknowledgement that students should have an opportunity to practice taking this new type of test, because it is a new delivery system and asks different types of questions. If you have not done so yet, please go to the Smarter Balanced practice test and have your student practice with it. In fact, I strongly encourage parents to try it, as well. The website link is: <u>http://sbac.portal.airast.org/</u> <u>practice-test/</u> You will find it very beneficial to spend time on this site, as it provides a hands-on opportunity to see what the test will look like.

If you have any questions, please feel free to talk to your CHEP teacher or contact me directly. I don't have all the answers, but am always happy to research and find out anything that you may want to know about the new standards and assessment. We are all in this together, as a community dedicated to learning, students, and families.


