A Note from the Principal: From the desk of Jane Doney

Welcome to the 2014-2015 school year! Summer is flying by and we are very excited about the coming year. There have been changes over the past few months- two site moves, farewell to beloved CHEP teachers, and the addition of new teachers in our program.

The CHEP South site has closed its doors, and is in the midst of merging with CHEP Central. A new classroom was created upstairs at Central, as well as a study area and a spot designated for hands-on science exploration. We are excited to have increased our capacity for classes and student learning and hope that families will take advantage of them.

Because of the build-out at CHEP Central, our administrative office has moved to Cypress, just two doors away from CHEP West. While administration's physical address has changed, please note that our phone numbers and email addresses have stayed the same.

We also said good-bye to four CHEP teachers since the end of last year. Marilyn Lagosz retired in June, after many years as a beloved CHEP teacher, and Julie Ames, Cindy Dimmit, and Patti Allen have moved to work at other sites in the ACCESS program. We will miss them all very much and the giftedness that they each brought to CHEP.

We also welcome three new teachers: Brian Hightower and Salena Burke will join the CHEP North staff, and Sylvana Kaliterna will be teaching at CHEP West. All three come from other ACCESS programs and bring a wealth of experience that will be beneficial to their families and our program.

Finally, an update on our math adoption. We have purchased Kindergarten – 5^{th} grade Go Math for the 2014-15 school year. We will purchase the 6^{th} – 8^{th} grade Go Math program in the 2015-16 school year. In the meantime, ALEKs math will be made available as a course option (at no cost) to students in 6^{th} – 8^{th} grade for this year, in addition to the math text we have previously used. ALEKs has implemented the new standards, and we are pleased to offer this interim option for our middle school students, if you are interested.

Whew ~ what a summer! It has been replete with change, growth and a lot of collaborative work. It is going to be a wonderful year and we are so thankful that you have chosen to be a part of our CHEP community!
