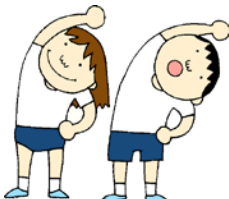

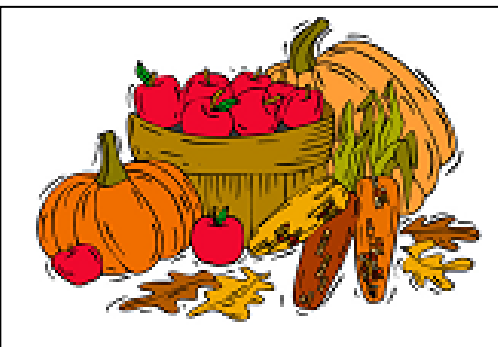
## **BOXTOP CONTEST**

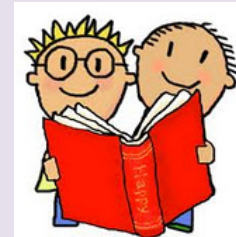
