- You must have a valid form of government identification to be fingerprinted. It can be a CA driver license, CA identification card, or passport. No student ID card will be accepted.
- We currently are taking credit card or cash as form of payment for Live Scan services.
- We ask that you arrive on time for your scheduled appointment. Please let us know if you are running late as we may have to reschedule the appointment for another day.

A few necessary forms will need to be filled out prior to your arrival. Additional paperwork may be needed once a technician determines your credentialing situation.

Child Development Permit - First Time Permits: Master Teacher and lower levels are eligible for stipend. Fingerprinting fees for this level may also be reimbursed for eligible applicants. Fingerprint reimbursement requests must be accompanied by an eligible permit application.
