Eligibility for Medals: Students must participate in all <b>six</b> events held on the following dates:  • Saturday, January 25, 2025 • Saturday, February 1, 2025	Eligibility for Medals: Students must participate in all <b>ten</b> events held on the following dates:  • Tuesday, January 14, 2025 • Saturday, January 25, 2025 • Saturday, February 1, 2025
Awards: Individual awards will be announced at the JV Virtual Awards Ceremony on February 13, 2025. Coaches can pick up their students' medals at the main competition awards ceremony on February 7, 2025.	Awards: Team and individual medals will be presented on February 7, 2025.
Iligibility for State Competition:     JV competitors are not eligible for the state competition.     Students in grades 9 and 10 must participate in the main competition to be eligible to advance to the state level competition.	Eligibility for State Competition:     Based upon overall team scores, students competing as a part of the school team may be invited to the California Academic Decathlon state competition.     Students competing individually as alternates or as a member of the school team are eligible to compete in the virtual California Academic Decathlon or Heptathlon.
