Iligibility for State Competition:     JV competitors are not eligible to compete at the inperson state competition, but may participate in the virtual California Academic Decathlon competition.	Eligibility for State Competition:     Based upon overall team scores, students competing as a part of the school team may be invited to the in-person California Academic Decathlon competition.     Students competing individually as alternates or as a member of the school team are eligible to compete in the virtual California Academic Decathlon.
