The <u>K-12 Advising Guide: Supporting Undocumented Students with the College Process</u> was created to help you support undocumented students throughout the college application and financial aid process.


Nominate a Counselor for 2025-26 Arthur S. Marmaduke High School Counselor Award Due November 17, 2025

The <u>award</u> was established in 1985 by the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) to honor the late Arthur Marmaduke, who served as the executive director of CSAC for 25 years, for his dedication and commitment to helping students gain access to postsecondary education through the CSAC's programs. Each year, CSAC selects a deserving high school counselor to receive this prestigious award in recognition of their exemplary work in helping students fulfill their dreams of attending college. The award includes a plaque and a \$1,500 check. Nominations can be submitted by district and county administrators, school counselors, teachers, principals, college administrators, and other school site officials.
