- ★ Upload each short response separately

#### **Short Response Questions**

You must respond to <u>only two</u> of the four questions; which questions you choose to answer is entirely up to you. Select questions most relevant to your experience and that best reflect your circumstances. All questions have equal consideration in the application review process, which means there is no advantage or disadvantage to choosing certain questions over others.

- 1. Describe the most significant challenge you have faced (academic, social, family, etc.). What steps have you taken or are you taking to overcome this challenge?
- 2. Describe your favorite academic subject. How do you imagine using this subject in your future (high school and/or beyond)?
- 3. Describe a talent or skill that you have. How have you developed and/or demonstrated that talent or skill over time?
- 4. Describe an example of your leadership experience. How has this influenced others, helped resolve disputes or contributed to a group?
