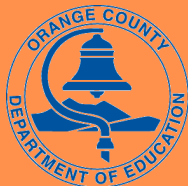




# One-Time Stipend Opportunity!

## Early Childhood Educators to Obtain Infant Toddler Units

The Orange County Workforce Pathways Stipend Program has a special one-time stipend for teachers wanting to obtain infant toddler units. This one-time stipend will cover the cost of tuition for up to 6 units taken at a community college.

In order to qualify you must meet the following requirements:

- *Have a CA Workforce Registry Number (visit <https://www.caregistry.org/> to attain a number)*
- *Work in a preschool classroom with children ages 0-5*
- *Work in an early learning setting that accepts some form of CA early learning subsidy either through a direct contract program (CSPP), General Child Care (CCTR), voucher subsidy alternative payment program (CAPP), Family Child Care Home Education Networks (CFCC), or CalWORKs Stages 1, 2, and 3*
- *Complete up to 6 units in Infant Toddler Coursework, that aligns with the CA early childhood permit (Infant Toddler Development/Infant Toddler Curriculum)*
- *Complete your courses between 3/2/2021 - 5/25/2022*
