ONLINE CERTIFICATION PROGRAM: GIFTED & TALENTED EDUCATION

This asynchronous course is designed with the busy professional in mind. The program is comprised of eight modules, based on effective strategies to increase learning opportunities and guide gifted students to reach their full potential. This training is intended for K-12 teachers, instructional coaches and administrators.

Earn a certification to teach students who are gifted and talented through research-based strategies at half the cost of a university program. Sessions will focus on characteristics of students who are gifted (including underrepresented gifted populations), and differentiation utilizing the GATE standards of acceleration, depth, complexity, and novelty, as well as strategies to enhance, enrich, and extend the core curriculum.
