Participants will synthesize session content and pedagogy by developing a civic action project for their classroom or school. By the end of the series, school teams will be prepared to apply for California Democracy School status, civic learning awards and the State Seal of Civic Engagement. Educators at the elementary and middle school levels will help students earn civic pathway certificates as well as develop civic dispositions and skills.
