This 24-hour workshop series introduces the CSU Expository Reading and Writing Curriculum (ERWC), including the following:

- Full-year ELA courses at grade 11 and grade 12
- Curriculum modules with integrated and designated ELD at grades 9-12

This professional learning is intended to be an active experience providing hands-on practice with the ERWC curriculum. These rich, adaptable resources are designed to help students develop the academic literacy skills necessary for success in college and the world of work. Aligned with the California Standards for ELA and ELD, both courses at grades 11 and 12 are approved to satisfy the "B" English subject requirement for UC and CSU admission. High schools may opt to offer the grade 11 course, the grade 12 course, or both. The modules for grades 9-12 with integrated and designated ELD may be integrated within existing ELA and ELD courses at those grades.

ONLINE FORMAT: Each session is four weeks in length comprised of asynchronous work and two synchronous meetings per week.
