Preparing High School Students for College-Level English

The CSU's Early Assessment Program (EAP) and the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) announce a professional learning experience for high school teachers.

This four-part professional development training will help teachers prepare students to meet college and university expectations, the standards of the CSU English Placement Test, and the CA State Standards. The University of California has approved ERWC for area "b" credit (from "a-g" requirements), and the course meets college preparatory requirements for both UC and CSU.
