



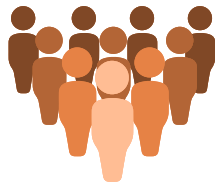
SYSTEM OF SUPPORT FOR EXPANDED LEARNING

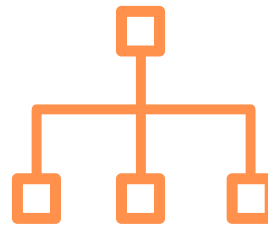
