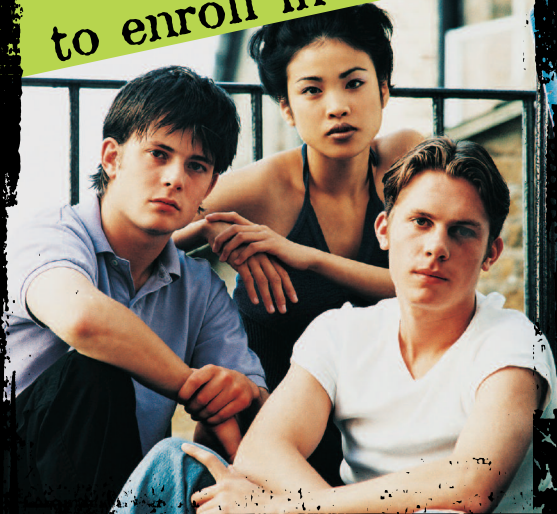

EVEN IF YOU:

- ☀ Don't have a permanent address
- ☀ Live in a shelter, hotel, motel, car, campground, or on the street
- ☀ Are doubled up with family or friends because you can't afford your own place
- ☀ Don't have your school or immunization records

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- ☀ Enroll in a school close to you
- ☀ Continue at the school where you were previously enrolled
- ☀ Receive transportation to school
- ☀ Receive free or reduced-price lunches
