Year 1 Installation Includes:

- Four days of whole team training
- Technical assistance and coaching
- Instruction in targeted interventions such as Check-In Check-Out
- Tier 2 teaming structures
- Use of screening data to inform intervention and monitor progress

Year 2 Implementation Includes:

- Two days of whole team training
- Technical assistance and coaching
- Data-based conversations for achieving student outcomes
- Action planning to achieve Tier 1 and Tier 2 fidelity of PBIS implementation in preparation for Tier 3 Readiness
