OCDE is committed to providing professional development that supports Orange County schools and districts implementing PBIS with fidelity within their Multi-Tiered System of Support. This is accomplished with respect to the Implementation Blueprint from the Center on PBIS and the California MTSS Framework.

Tier 1 \$6,500 per Team

Tier 1 PBIS professional learning focuses on the co-creation of school-wide behavioral supports through a team-led process.

Year 1 Installing: Tier 1 teams engage in 4 days of in-person learning to install PBIS universal systems, practices, and data. **Training Dates: 09/24/24, 11/19/24, 01/30/25, 04/22/25**

Year 2 Implementing: Professional learning builds to include data-based conversations, deeper implementation in the classroom, and action planning. **Training Dates: 2 days in 2025/26 TBD**

Tier 2 \$6,500 per Team

Tier 2 PBIS professional learning prioritizes using data to identify practices that will support students who need supplemental supports through team-built systems.

Year 1 Installing: Tier 2 teams engage in 4 days of in-person learning to install supplemental interventions, including exploring and building the supporting systems and data for implementation. **Training Dates: 10/24/24, 12/12/24, 01/14/25, 03/04/25**

Year 2 Implementing: Professional learning builds to fully implement Check-in Check-out, explore Tier 2 practices for contextual fit, and increase Tier 2 fidelity of implementation. **Training Dates: 2 days in 2025/26 TBD**

Tier 3 \$6,500 per Team

Tier 3 supports focus on the individual behaviors of students whose needs are not met by universal and secondary practices. OCDE currently offers training on Prevent Teach Reinforce (PTR) which is an evidence-based process for assessing students' needs and responding with suitable prevention, teaching, and reinforcement strategies.

Tier 3 Installing: Tier 3 team engages with professional learning to build systems and data for identifying & responding to intensive student needs, while a student-centered team will build a comprehensive behavior plan.

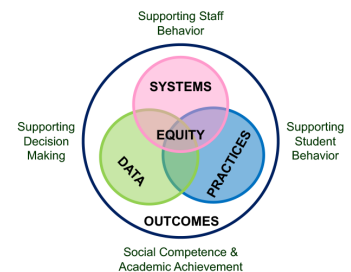
Tier 3 Implementing: Tier 3 team continues to build sustainable systems and data practices while student-centered teams receive more practice and technical assistance for behavior support planning. If interested in PTR training, please contact Ginny Joseph vjoseph@ocde.us

Tier 1 Booster Training - \$4500 per Team

Tier 1 PBIS Booster Training is designed for teams who need a refresher on Tier 1 PBIS implementation, need to increase their fidelity of implementation, and/or need to update their implementation with culturally relevant and trauma-informed practices. School Site teams should expect a focus on response strategies and Classroom PBIS.
