RP to Support Academic Success

Affective Statements, Questions and Circles provide an opportunity to deepen knowledge, engage in perspective taking and build on self and social awareness. This is where can see a strong integration of SEL and RP to support academic success.

Building Community & Strengthening Relationships

The presence of community and healthy relationships is what anchors Social Capital. This is the network of relationships among people who live and work in a particular society, enabling that society to function effectively. Through Restorative Practices, we provide a Tiered system of support that allows us to spend 80% of what we do in prevention and 20% in responding. These practices foster leadership, accountability, effective and healthy communication.

Implementing Circles

Circles are most widely known to build community and relationships. They can also be used to deepen our knowledge around academic content, encourage problem solving and increase accountability and responsibility.

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Fundamentals of Behavior Instruction,

Aligning Practices Across RP, PBIS, SEL, & UDL

Restorative Practices aligns and integrates into the great work that is already taking place. RP fosters and enhances the 5 SEL competencies as well as strengthens our support for behavior through expectations, consequences and re entry. RP is essential in how we provide opportunities to engage, learn and process information.
