This grant will provide an opportunity for school sites and LEAs to build capacity to support the implementation of a multi-tiered system of support to improve outcomes for all learners.

GRANT TIMELINE

- Application due:
October 15, 2022 by 5:00 PM PST
- Award announcement: 11/15/22
- Awardee orientation meeting:

- Implementation plan development

- Course completion window:
March 2023 - March 2025

GRANT SPECIFICS

- Engage in coaching to support implementation of the CA MTSS Framework and completion of the CA MTSS Pathway Certification for Schools course. Consortia awardees will provide coaching from the lead agency.
- Goal of 90% of school staff to complete the CA MTSS Pathway Certification for Schools course during the 24-month window (course completion ETA: 40-60 hours)
- Utilize grant funds to cover stipends and/or substitute coverage for staff completion of the course
- Gather and submit data, including, but not limited to: Fidelity Integrity Assessment, Schoolwide Implementation Tool, attendance, discipline, school climate and perception surveys

APPLICATION TYPES AND AWARD AMOUNTS

- Apply as an individual school: \$50,000 for schools with up to 1,000 students
- Apply as an individual school: \$100,000 for schools over 1,000 students
- Apply as a consortium: up to 5 schools and one lead agency, will receive \$50,000 each, plus, lead agency will receive \$15,000 for fiscal and contract support. Maximum available funding: \$315,000
- Apply as a COE to build coaching capacity: \$50,000
