Phase 3 CA MTSS Sub-Grant for County Offices of Education

Dear COE colleagues,

Thank you for your continued partnership to further support our CA MTSS implementation efforts to enhance school conditions and climate. The California Department of Education in partnership with the Orange County Department of Education and the Butte County Office of Education are pleased to announce the Phase 3 CA MTSS

Sub-grant. This grant will provide an opportunity for school sites, LEAs, and county offices of education to build capacity for coaching and implementation of CA MTSS to improve outcomes for all learners.

Phase 3 of the CA MTSS Sub-grant will provide funding to COEs, LEAs, consortiums, and schools. Identified awardees (schools or consortia) will commit to having at least 90% of school staff (including administrators, teachers, school counselors, school psychologists, paraeducators, and school-based mental health clinicians) completion of the CA MTSS Pathway Certification for Schools online course; estimated completion time 40-60 hours between March 2022 - June 2026. In order to achieve this goal, coaching and technical assistance from county offices of education is needed and desired.

COEs will be awarded \$50,000 to support their efforts to provide technical assistance to schools and/or consortiums that are awarded the sub-grant. Funds must be encumbered by June 30, 2025 but may be expended through June 30, 2026

Grant Requirements for COEs:

- Support execution of the capacity building plan to increase the number of COE staff ready to support CA

- MTSS implementation for local schools and LEAs
- Provide coaching for award site administrator(s) and/or consortium leads on a regular basis
 - The designated coach who will support the grant funded school(s) in their area to complete the CA MTSS Pathway Certification for Schools (Coaching Pathway) online course by or before March 2023 ; estimated completion time 40-60 hours
 - Engage in the continuous improvement process to create systemic change needed to improve outcomes for all learners
 - Gather and submit data

Data collection: March 2022 - June 2026
