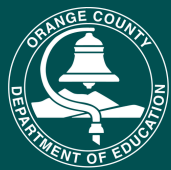


Project GLAD[®] Agency Trainers attend four days of training per module that includes facilitation strategies, coaching moves, and planning for site-based implementation
