OCDE Preschool GLAD® Training of Trainers

OCDE Preschool GLAD® is about creating a rich environment of language, ideas and concepts. This training prepares participants to provide the one-day overview of the OCDE Preschool GLAD® model and the classroom demonstration.

Part I: 1-DAY RESEARCH AND THEORY WORKSHOP

Participants will explore strategies for working with adult learners, work in collaborative groups, deepen

understanding of the OCDE Preschool GLAD® model, and develop essential skills as presenters, facilitators, and coaches. Trainers in training will review and reflect on the theoretical base for the training and the strategies that promote academic language, literacy, and cross-cultural respect.

Part II: 4-DAY CLASSROOM DEMONSTRATION

Participants will observe OCDE Preschool GLAD® presented by two OCDE Preschool GLAD® trainers. Additional instruction by OCDE Preschool GLAD® trainers will support candidates with

processing, reflecting, learning, collaborating, and planning in a variety of groupings. Each candidate will also coach and teach at least one strategy during the week and have a variety of opportunities to reflect and receive feedback.
