

Apply for the PCHS chapter of California Scholarship Federation

Why?

CSF acknowledges your academic achievement, looks great on college applications, and may open the door for scholarship opportunities.

Extra Perks?

If you get sealbearer status (membership for 4 of your last 6 semesters – 3 semesters for students graduating as juniors), you receive a special seal on your diploma, an indication of Sealbearer status on your transcript, and a gold cord and at graduation.

Does it take much time or effort?

Nope. You're already doing the work by getting good grades. There might be one meeting during the semester.

Do you qualify?

First, you must be at least a second semester freshman. Second, using the preceding fall/spring semester's report card, the computations below, and the following lists, figure out if you have 10 CSF points. If so, you qualify! Complete an application and turn it in at the front desk. If not, no worries – there's always next semester. **This is a semester-to-semester membership, so members must reapply each semester.**

What now?

If you think you qualify, print out the following application and return your completed application in by the posted date. If you have any questions, please contact us.

Computations:

These computations are based on your report card from the previous fall or spring semester; **please attach a copy of your report card to your application.** You must have completed at least two courses from List I with a minimum of 4 points. An additional 3 points and an additional class must come from List I or II. The remaining 3 points can come from List I, II or III. Seniors in their last semester may use 3 courses from List II and none from List I. Only 5 courses may be used for computation for any student.

Points for 10 credit classes:	Points for 5 credit classes:	Points for 2.5 credit classes:

Notes: Disqualification for the semester results from a D or F in any class. No points are given for classes taken on a credit/no credit basis, for P.E., or for subjects repeated to improve a grade. Summer courses don't count unless the student has not taken sufficient List I and II courses during the previous semester and then only one course may be used per semester.
