Transition to High School

Question	Answer

If a parent would like to submit a request for an Intra-District transfer, how do they know which special education programs are available at the different school sites?	Open Enrollment is January 17- February 3, 2023. At your school of residence, complete the transfer process and indicate your choice of school. Factors to consider for placement at a transfer school include, but are not limited to, space availability and if the special education program is offered at this choice school and also meets your child's FAPE.
Will the Certificate of Completion cause issues with college? If a student completes the Certificate of Completion program and does not receive a diploma, can they later go to college?	It may - in some cases, students are able to enroll in community colleges, however, it depends on the school and the student's abilities.
Has the age of 22 been extended due to COVID?	No, there have been no changes.
Can a diploma track student take 5 years to complete the diploma if necessary?	The IEP team will have to determine the reason why the student is not progressing at the expected rate. It would depend on what courses have not been completed in four years.

<p>Is transportation available for students in the High School District?</p>	<p>Transportation is a related service and will be discussed at your child's transition IEP. If a student is accepted on an Intra-District transfer, no transportation will be provided.</p>
<p>What resources are available to help bridge students from Adult Transition Program (ATP) to college?</p>	<p>If the student is enrolled in the Adult Transition Program (ATP), an IEP team meeting may be held to collaborate and discuss the transition to college or exit from ATP at the age of 22. Additional resources and connections to community college can be provided.</p>
<p>Do all FJUHSD schools have approx. 1900 students? If not, what is the average size of a high school within the district?</p>	<p>Average enrollment across school sites is 2100 students.</p>
<p>Can a student "repeat" a year if needed?</p>	<p>A request for retention would be reviewed by the IEP team, with the focus on how to support the student in an appropriate program that addresses his/her unique needs.</p>
<p>If my child qualifies for an IEP, can they still receive help after graduation?</p>	<p>The district can provide you with resources that exist in the community if you wish to pursue support after you student graduates from public school.</p>
