В.	Preparation:			
	1. Identifies student's ability to participate in procedure			
	2. Reviews universal precautions			
	3. Identifies where/when procedure is done			
	4. Identifies proper positioning for procedure			
	5. Identifies body parts:			
	a. Foreskin			
	b. Meatus			
	c. Glans			
	d. Urethra			
	6. Identifies possible problems and appropriate			
	actions.			
C.	Identifies needed supplies:			
	1. Catheter			
	2. Gloves			
	3. Lubricant			
	4. Cleansing supplies			
	5. Container to collect urine			
D.	Procedure:			
	1. Washes hands			
	2. Assembles equipment			
	3. Assists student with clothing removal/adjustment			
	and explains procedure			
	4. Positions student properly			
	5. Puts on gloves			
	6. Lubricates catheter and places on clean surface			
	7. Cleans			
	a. Retracts foreskin (if uncircumcised)			
	b. Holds penis at 45-90 degree angle from the			
	abdomen			
	c. Pulls penis straight			
	d. Cleans meatus			
	e. Using clean supplies each time, repeats cleaning			
	procedure three times			
	8. Inserts well-lubricated catheter into urethra with			
	consistent pressure until urine flows (if muscle			
	spasm occurs, stop momentarily and then try again			
	use slow, even pressure) Never force a catheter			
	9. Allows urine to flow by gravity into the collecting container or toilet			
	10. Rotates catheter so that catheter opening reaches all bladder areas			

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11. When urine stops flowing, pinches catheter and withdraws slowly	
12. Pulls foreskin over glans (if not circumcised)	
13. Removes gloves and washes hands	
14. Assists student with dressing	
15. If ordered, observes for urine abnormalities,	
measures volume and records findings	
16. Discards urine and disposable equipment properly	
17. Washes any equipment that is to be used again	
18. Documents procedure and observations	
19. Reports any changes/abnormalities to School Nurse
