	1. Identifies student's ability to participate in procedure.			
	2. Reviews universal precautions.			
	3. Identifies where/when procedure is done.			
	4. Identifies possible problems and appropriate			
	actions.			
C.	Identifies needed supplies.			
D.	Procedure			
	1. Washes hands.			
	2. Assembles equipment.			
	3. Reassures student.			
	4. Opens package.			
	5. Puts on gloves.			
	6. Puts obturator into tracheostomy tube.			
	7. Attaches ties, lubricates tube if necessary.			
	8. Positions student appropriately.			
	9. Standing in front of stoma, inserts tube using a downward arc.			
	10. Holds tube, removes obturator. Inserts inner cannula if needed.			
	11. Listens and feels for air movement through tube.			
	12. Secures tube in place.			
	13. Performs necessary skin care, applies gauze as needed.			
	14. Discards used equipment appropriately (saving			
	tracheostomy tube in bag for parents if desired).			
	15. Documents procedure and notifies			
	parent/caregiver.
