## REDEVELOPMENT OVERSIGHT BOARD CRITERIA FOR SELECTION ORANGE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

Under AB1X 26, the County Superintendent of Schools is charged with the responsibility to appoint one board member to Oversight Boards for each of the Redevelopment Successor Agencies in Orange County. The appointees serve at the pleasure of the County Superintendent. Based on discussions with an advisory committee consisting of school district administrators, the County Superintendent of Schools will appoint representatives for the school districts that are included in the redevelopment area. The suggested selection criteria include the following factors:

## I. Criteria for Choosing School District

- A. Largest number of projects or largest pass through amount
- B. Capacity of district and district staff
- C. Preference of school districts
- D. Largest incremental assessed value

## II. Recommended Qualifications of Individual Representative

- A. Knowledge of and experience with school district needs and practices with respect to redevelopment
- B. Knowledge of and experience with school finance
- C. Knowledge of and experience with contract law, public policy, interagency relations, capital facilities, and public finance
- D. Business experience
- E. Ability to advocate the interests of the school districts in the redevelopment area
- F. Ability to negotiate on behalf of all the districts in the redevelopment area
- G. Ability to attend all meetings and make decisions at the meetings
- H. Ability to make a four year commitment.
