Subject: CalSTRS Defined Benefit Supplement Refunds

The California State Teachers' Retirement System (CalSTRS) has completed their review of compensation reported to the defined benefit (DB) program for fiscal year 2015-16 and has returned excess contributions associated with earnings which have been moved to members' defined benefit supplement (DBS) accounts.

Excess contributions are the result of the CalSTRS DBS program having contribution rates which are lower than that of the DB program. Earnings transferred from DB to DBS accounts result in an overpayment of contributions by school districts and their employees. The table below lists the contribution rates in effect during 2015-16 and the difference between DB and DBS contribution rates.

| | DB Contribution Rate | DBS Contribution Rate | Difference (Excess) |
|----------|----------------------|-----------------------|---------------------|
| Employer | 10.73% | 8.25% | 2.48% |
| Employee | 9.20% | 8.00% | 1.20% |

The Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) has received payment from CalSTRS for all contributions to be refunded to Orange County districts and employees totaling \$4,337,382.53, along with a breakdown of refund amounts by employee.

Two-Step Process for Refunding Contributions

Step 1: Return all funds to districts

OCDE will transfer the total amount of excess contributions (employee and employer) to each school district. The total amount being refunded to each district has been provided in the attached report. Funds will be transferred to the following fund-objects:

K-12 Districts 01-8699
 Community College Districts 01-8890

• Charter Schools 01-8699 or 09-8699

Step 2: Payroll adjustments to refund employee contributions

OCDE will create payroll adjustment entries within the County Payroll System to refund employee contributions and adjust taxable wages accordingly.

Charter schools not processing payroll through OCDE will need to issue employee refunds and adjust taxable wages through their payroll service provider.

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OCDE will notify districts once fund transfers have been completed and after adjustment entries have been created in the County Payroll System. We expect that both steps in the refund process will occur by October 31, 2016. Our goal is to have the payroll adjustments processed on the 04A (10/31/2016) certificated payroll cycle.

Moving Forward

It is our understanding that CalSTRS will distribute annual member statements in October 2016 and excess contributions (refunds) will be listed as a separate line item in these statements. As such, districts may receive calls from employees regarding the status of refunds. Employees receiving refunds will see the amount listed as "STRS DBS REFUND" on their 04A paystub. A sample employee notification memo has been attached for your reference and use.

Please note that in the future this process of refunding excess contributions may occur on a quarterly basis. CalSTRS has communicated that the agency expects to return excess contributions on a more frequent basis. OCDE is planning to process these refunds each quarter. The amount of excess contributions refunded each year will increase as DB contribution rates continue to increase until 2020-21, when employer contribution rates reach 19.1%.

Refund of Excess DBS Contributions

As a member of the California State Teachers' Retirement System (CalSTRS), you may have received notification from CalSTRS through the mail or via email regarding excess member contributions having been reported to your Defined Benefit Supplement (DBS) account. A sample notification from CalSTRS has been included below for your reference.

Excess contributions are the result of changing CalSTRS contribution rates. CalSTRS notifies districts of the refund amounts due to staff members each year in October. Our district has worked closely with the Orange County Department of Education to expedite the processing of these refunds so that active staff members will receive them on the 11/10/2016 (04C) paycheck.

The refund amount will be displayed as **STRS DBS REFUND** on your paycheck in the box labeled **Other Deductions** (see example below).

Excess Member Contributions Reported

Dear CalSTRS member,

Our records indicate you earned compensation for service in excess of one year in the 2014–15 school year. As a result, your member contributions made on this service in excess of the 8 percent contribution rate for Defined Benefit Supplement compensation will be returned to you by your employer.

Under the 2014 CalSTRS Funding Plan, approved by the Governor under AB 1469, member contribution rates for the Defined Benefit Program increased beginning July 1, 2014. The member contribution rate for compensation creditable to the Defined Benefit Supplement Program, which includes compensation earned for service in excess of one year, is still 8 percent and contributions made in excess of this amount must be returned to the employer. For more information about the CalSTRS Funding Plan, visit CalSTRS.com/plan-funding.

We will return excess contributions to your employer in October. Since you were in service retirement status on or before September 4, 2015, you will not receive a Retirement Progress Report this fall. You will find a report of your excess member contributions online on your myCalSTRS account (under the Services tab). Your employer is responsible for returning your excess member contributions to you, less any authorized adjustments or tax withholding. Keep in mind it may take 30 or more days for the excess member contributions to be transferred from CalSTRS to your employer. The return of your excess member contributions from your employer will vary. If you have any questions regarding the return of your excess contributions, please contact your employer.

Your returned pre-tax member contributions are considered taxable income in the year you receive the funds regardless of when you initially paid the contributions.
