

Me in My World Vocabulary



Adaptation	A behavior or characteristic that helps a plant or animal survive in the environment
Animal	A living that is not a plant.
Biologist	A person who studies living things
Bird	A warm-blooded, two-legged, egg-laying animal. It has a backbone, wings, and a body covered with feathers.
Habitat	The place where a plant or animal lives that has food, water, shelter, and space
Invertebrate	An animal that does not have a backbone
Mammal	A warm-blooded animal that has hair and a back bone; the young feed on mother's milk.
Reptile	A cold-blooded animal that has a backbone and a body covered with scales or horny plates
Vertebrate	An animal that has a backbone

Note: The focus of this program is exploring these science concepts, not memorizing these terms. This is done at an appropriate level for kindergarten.
