Do you need to calculate age from a date of birth? Forget using a calculator or counting the months and years long-hand! Just insert this formula in the cell next to date of birth:

$$
\begin{gathered}
=\text { DATEDIF(A2,TODAY(),"y")\&" years "\&DATEDIF(A2,TODAY(),"ym")\&" months } \\
\text { "\&DATEDIF(A2,TODAY(),"md")\&" days" }
\end{gathered}
$$

Remember that "A2" is the cell with the date of birth information. Update that reference for each new record, or just auto-fill the formula down an entire range of entries.
