Got the perfect presentation graphic, but want to remove the background? PowerPoint 2010 makes this possible with the simple click of your mouse!

- 1. On any slide in a PowerPoint 2010 presentation, click on the **insert** tab.
- 2. In the Images group, select the "picture" icon
- 3. Browse your computer to find the picture, and double click on it. Your picture has now been dropped onto your PowerPoint slide.
- 4. Click on the picture to activate it.
- 5. In the Format ribbon, click on the "remove background" icon.
- 6. Click the "keep changes" icon. The background on your graphic has been removed.

Note: you can remove or add portions that have been removed by selecting "mark areas to keep" or "mark areas to remove" and clicking on the spaces in the picture.
