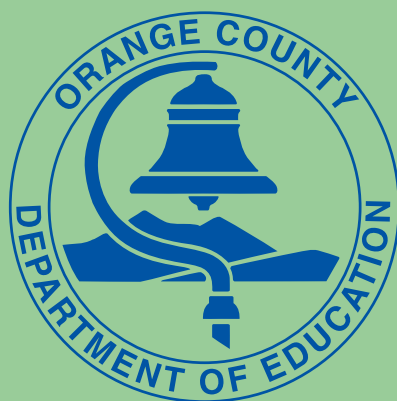

## FALL 2010 RACIAL AND ETHNIC SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

The Fall 2010 Racial and Ethnic Survey report was compiled and published by the Business Services Division of the Orange County Department of Education, containing data extracted from the California Longitudinal Pupil Achievement Data System (CALPADS) filed by schools in Orange County to the California Department of Education (CDE). It also contains data extracted from DataQuest, the CDE developed and maintained system that provides reports on accountability, staffing and student-level data.

For the purpose of this report, we have chosen to combine the Multiple and Missing categories to be consistent with the way data was reported in the previous year's Racial and Ethnic Survey. In some cases, year-over-year changes in race and ethnicity can be attributed to school districts re-surveying students using the latest federal definitions of the racial and ethnic categories.

County-wide enrollment increased from the prior year by 480 students or 0.10%. The ethnic category with the greatest increase in the number of students enrolled was Asian, with an increase of 2.29% or 1,841 students. The ethnic category with the greatest decline in the number of enrolled students was Multiple/Missing, with a decline of 8.79% or 1,331 students.

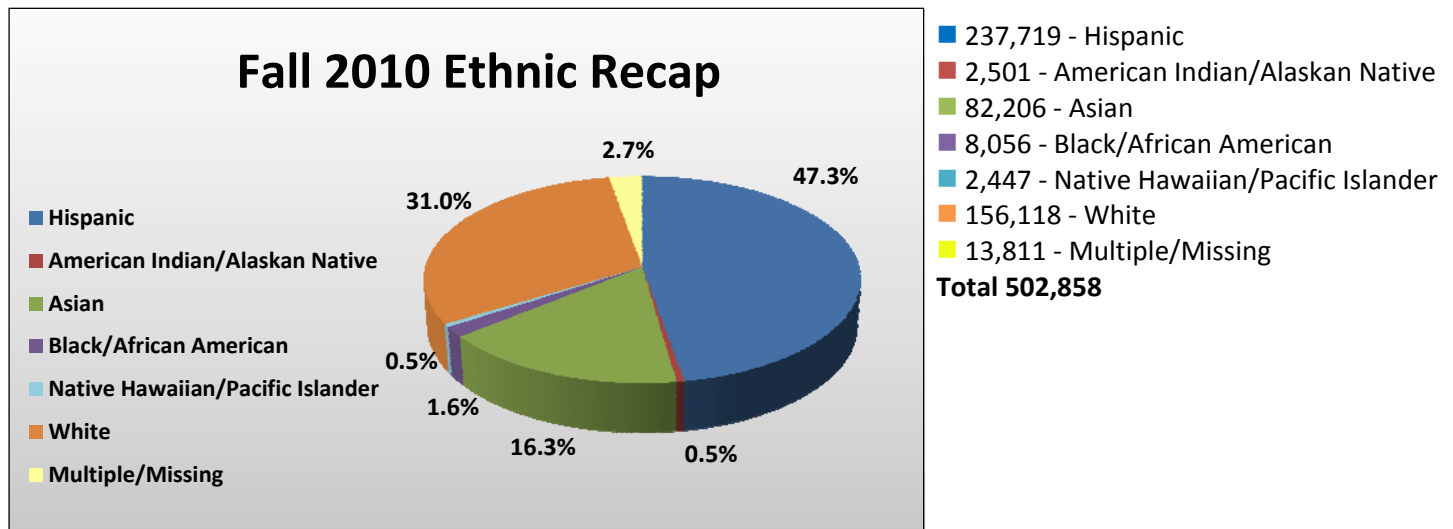
County-wide, Orange County had an increase of 3.60% or 1,257 graduating students from the prior year. The ethnic categories with the greatest increases in graduates were Hispanics with an increase of 10.95% or 1,349 graduates, and Multiple/Missing, with an increase of 60.32% or 260 graduates.

## FALL 2010 RACIAL AND ETHNIC SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS (continued)

In order to be consistent with figures reported by the CDE, dropout counts are calculated for grades 9 through 12 in K-12 school districts excluding grades 7 and 8 and county office programs. Dropout rate calculations compare the counts of dropouts over the entire school year with a single day enrollment count on Information Day (first Wednesday of October). Calculations posted on the CDE website include a 1-year reported rate, an adjusted 1-year rate, a reported 4-year derived rate and an adjusted 4-year derived rate.

Reported rates are solely based off information submitted by school districts to the CDE via CALPADS. Adjusted rates are calculated to include reenrolled dropout students and lost transfer students. The 4-year derived dropout rate is an estimate of the percent of students who would drop out in a four year period based on data collected for a single year. The dropout rates included within this survey are 1-year rate calculations based on reported school district counts of dropouts and enrollment.

County-wide, Orange County had a decrease of 7.31% or 153 dropouts in grades 9 – 12 from the prior year. The percentage of dropouts in Orange County also decreased from 1.3% to 1.2%, and this figure is still significantly lower than the California statewide dropout percentage of 3.4%.

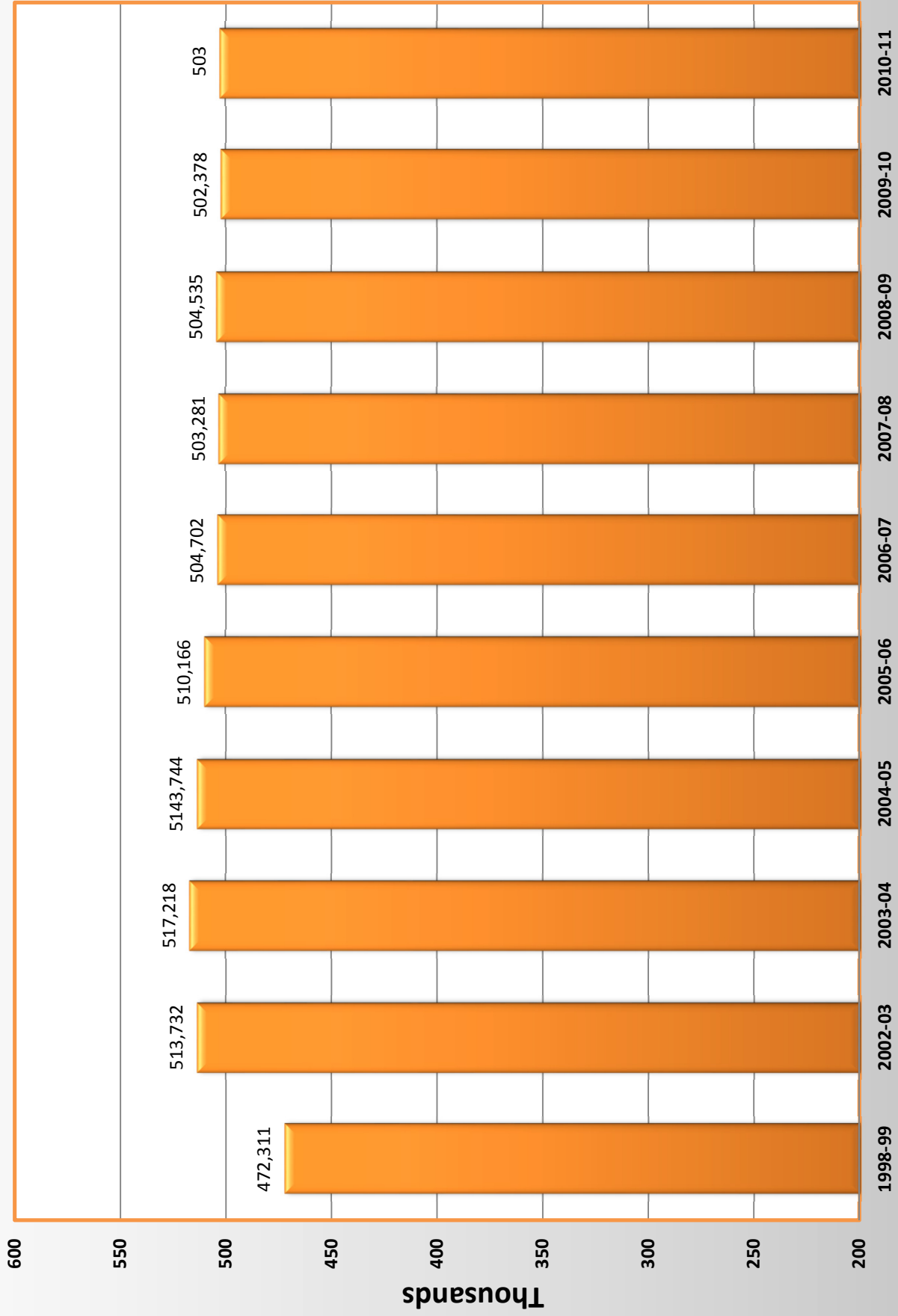

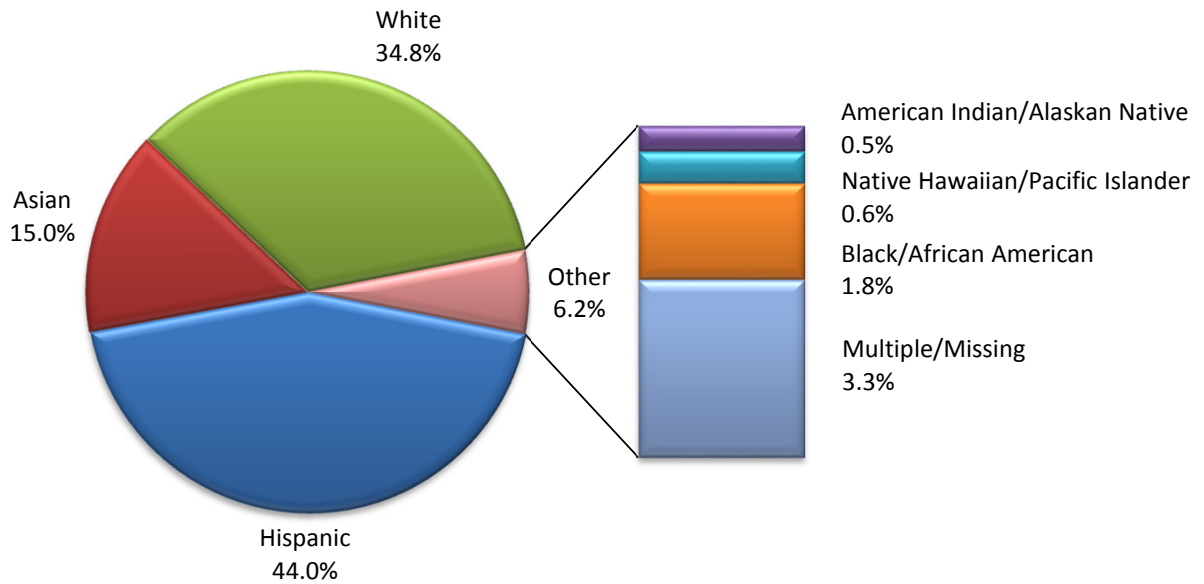


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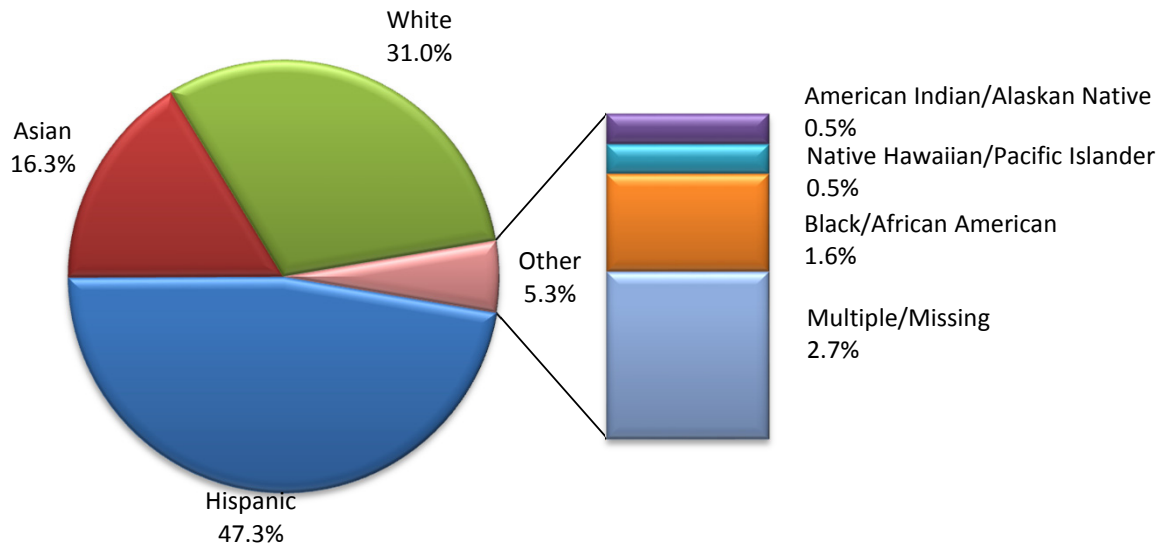

In 2010-11, countywide enrollment increased by 0.1%. We had 14 districts that experienced declining enrollment, and 13 districts that experienced increasing enrollment. Current trend indicates that enrollment will remain relatively flat in 2011-12.

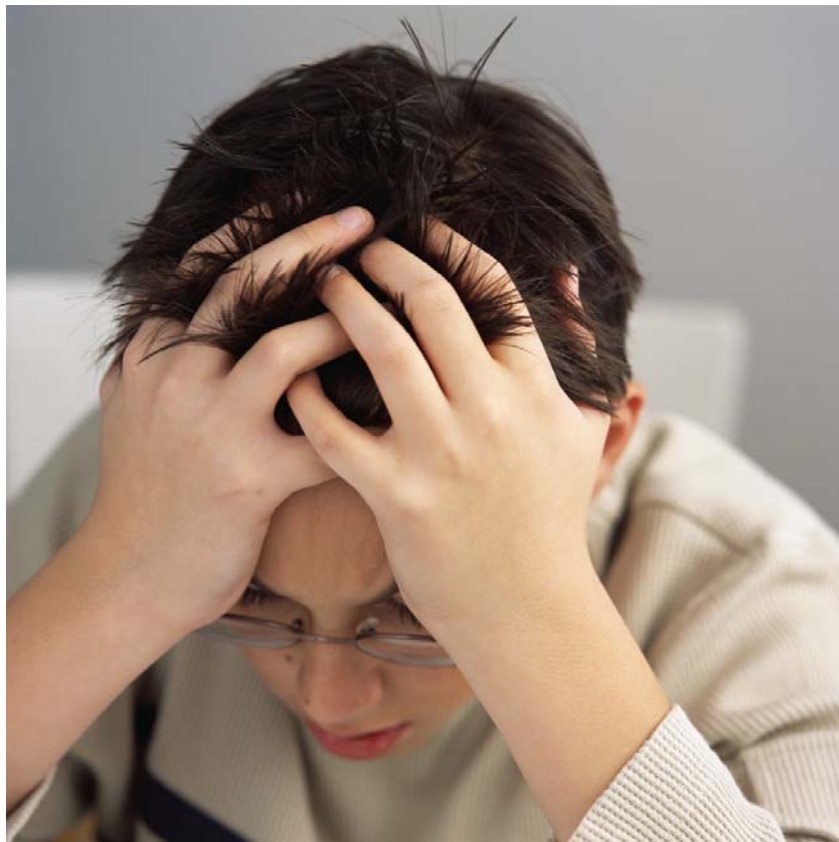

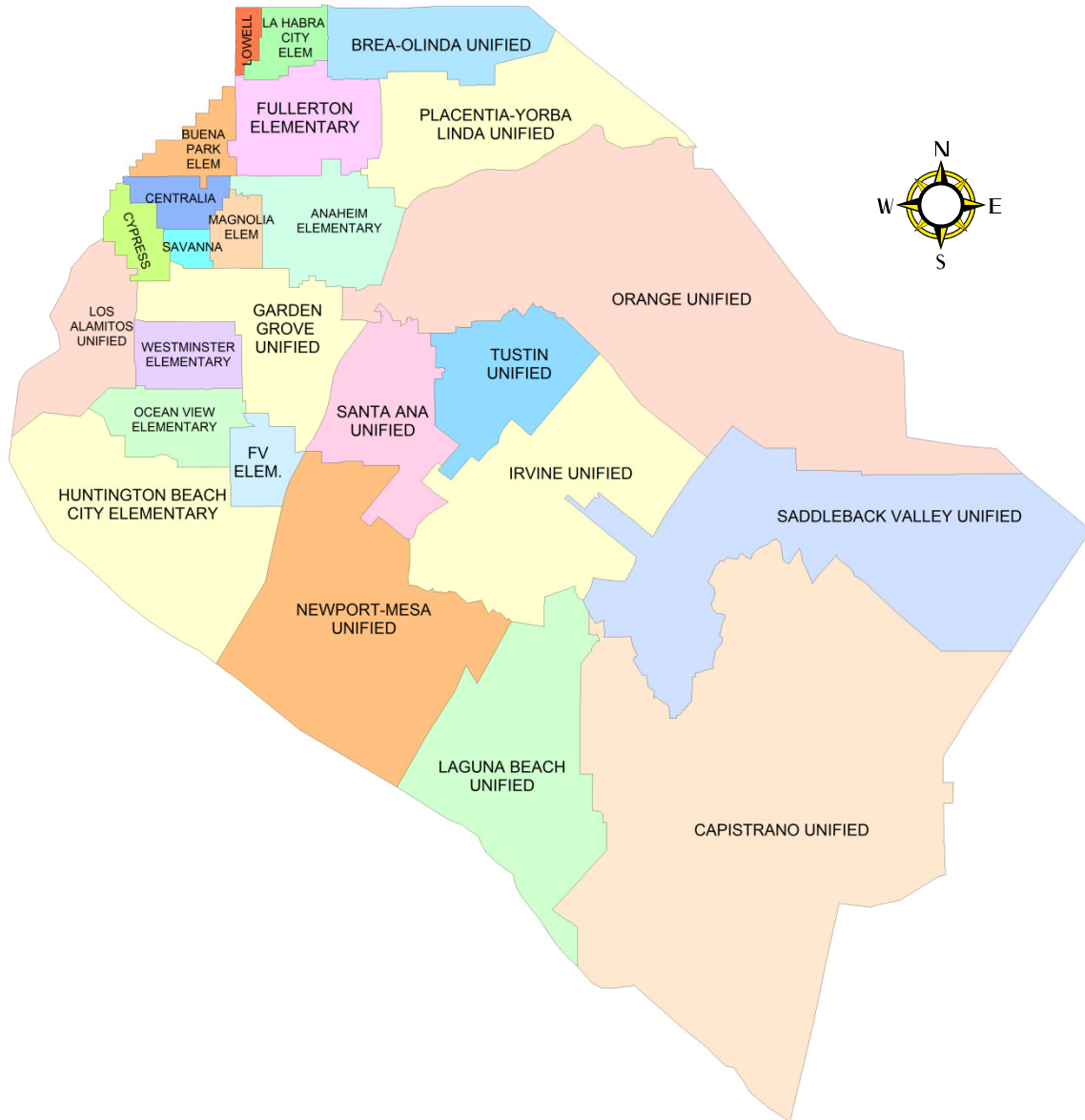
