

Face Covering Requirement

On January 5, 2022, the California Department of Public Health extended its statewide requirement for universal masking in all indoor public settings, irrespective of vaccination status, from December 15, 2021 through February 15, 2022. Similarly, on January 4, 2022, the Orange County Health Care Agency ordered that masks are required for all individuals in all indoor public settings, regardless of vaccination status, from December 15, 2021 through January 15, 2022. This Order applies to all public meetings.

All individuals attending the County Committee Meeting will be required to wear a face mask. We appreciate everyone's cooperation and adherence to this requirement as we are working to keep everyone healthy and safe.

If you are in this public building, including in this County Committee Meeting, you are required to wear a face mask at all times including during public comment.

Members of the public who cannot wear a mask or choose not to, may view the County Committee Meeting from the outdoor location that has been setup to allow remote viewing.
