Job Description: Under the supervision and guidance of the ROP and school site administration, plan and implement learning activities which enable high school students to develop knowledge and skills needed for employment or advanced training.

Requirements/Qualifications: Must have at least 3 years of industry experience in **Automotive field**.

Curriculum Knowledge: Advanced knowledge of hand/power tools, internal combustion engines, fuel and emission control systems, auto clutch, manual and automatic transmissions, final drive units, tires-wheels-bearings; -suspension –brake –electrical -charging, -starting systems, and engines. The course includes both classroom instruction and hands-on auto shop training.

Typical Responsibilities

- Provide group and individual instruction to high school students of varying abilities, utilizing effective teaching strategies, aids, and equipment.
- Evaluate students' skills and job readiness competencies.
- Monitor student progress on ITP (Individualized Training Plans), revise plans as needed.
- Maintain accurate student records.
- Manage classroom and shop in a manner conducive to learning.
- Develop lesson plans and implement instruction, enabling students to master competencies in a state-approved course outline.
- Collaborate in planning process for modifications in curriculum.
- Develop and maintain an active subject matter advisory committee.
- Develop and maintain positive contacts with employers to develop training and placement opportunities for students.
- Keep abreast of current industry practices and training methods.
- Participate in available inservice training, workshops, and seminars to maintain an awareness of current practices in the field.
- Perform other duties as required.

Knowledge/Skills/Abilities

- Knowledge and experience in computer software applications and internet applications; methods and techniques of effective presentations; skills in verbal and written communications; teaching strategies and learning modalities.
- Ability to organize environment and instruction to facilitate learning; write lesson plans for individual and group instruction; use diverse teaching strategies to meet students' learning styles, abilities, interests, and cultural backgrounds; follow ROP policy/procedure, including maintaining student and other required records; relate to students; and work effectively as a team member.
