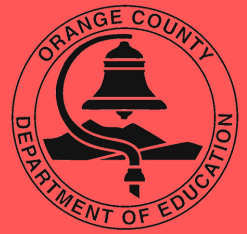

Teams will attend "Year 1: Installation" followed by "Year 2: Implementation" where they will engage in learning around intensive systems, practices, and data necessary to successfully create positive, safe, predictable, and equitable learning environments.

Year 1 Installation Includes:

- Four days of whole team training
- Technical assistance and coaching
- Instruction in intensive interventions such as Prevent Teach Reinforce (PTR)
- Tier 3 Teaming Structures
- Develop Student Centered Team to build a student behavior plan

Year 2 Implementation Includes:

- Two days of whole team training
- Technical assistance and coaching
- Data-based conversations for Tier 3 systems and individual student outcomes
- Action planning to achieve Tier 1, 2, and 3 fidelity of implementation
