## REFERRAL FOR SERVICES AND/OR TREATMENT

On occasion program staff, school staff, parents, and/or community members may want to refer a child or youth to appropriate support services. The following may be helpful in making a decision on what to do:

- As our program staff becomes aware of a need for a child, youth and/or parent/guardian, the appropriate school site staff is contacted. Appropriate staff at each school site may include the following administration staffs: principal, assistant principal, school psychologist, nurse, school counselor and/or a health technician that are aware of the schools policy for referrals and of local or county community services.
- A general directory for counseling and other support services, which are available in multiple languages, is accessed by calling 2-1-1 or at <a href="http://www.211oc.org">http://www.211oc.org</a>. This service is available 24 hours a day.
- Suicide Prevention Crisis Line can be accessed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week by calling toll-free in Orange County 877-727-4747. Online information about this service is available at http://www.didihirsch.org.
- A document called *Finding a Therapist* is available on our School-based Mental Health Services program website, <a href="http://pei.ocde.us">http://pei.ocde.us</a>, which provides links and numbers to licensed professionals and organizations to help find a therapist for counseling support. - Continuum of Care: Communities provide different types of treatment programs and services for children and adolescents with mental illnesses. A complete range of programs and services is called the continuum of care. Not every community has every type of service or program on the continuum.
