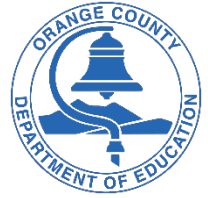

# **PROGRAM BENEFITS**

## **YOUTH SERVING ORGANIZATIONS**

The Orange County Friday Night Live Partnership (OCFNLP) provides opportunities for positive and healthy youth development by engaging youth as active leaders and resources in their communities. The research-based program encourages youth to take responsibility by creating and coordinating alcohol, tobacco, and other drug prevention activities and community service projects that benefit their peers and communities. This youth-driven model develops skills in the areas of leadership, communication, team building, and problem solving.

OCFNLP programs, including Friday Night Live (youth in grades 9-12), Club Live (youth in grades 6-8), and Friday Night Live Kids (youth in grades 4-6) can be implemented in youth serving organizations, including after-school programs, resource and community centers, and youth ministries.

The Orange County Department of Education provides:

- A program open to youth in grades 4-12 at no cost to the organization
- Ongoing technical assistance, resources, and support for implementation of proven effective alcohol, tobacco, and drug prevention strategies
- Skill development trainings for youth
- Advisor training and support
- Site specific program evaluation data
- Opportunities for youth to make positive contributions to their communities
