3.0 Approval of the North Orange County Special Education Local Plan Area 2020-2021 Local Plan Sections (A) Contacts and Certification and (B) Governance and Administration

The California Department of Education requires all SELPAs to develop a Local Plan, which includes an Annual Budget Plan and an Annual Service Plan. The purpose of these plans is to provide the general public with a summary of where special education services are provided throughout the SELPA by each local education agency. The Annual Budget Plan documents the general revenue sources coming into the SELPA. The California Department of Education requires that all SELPAs throughout California submit their respective Local Plans by June 30, 2021.

4.0 Approval of the North Orange County Special Education Local Plan Area 2020-2021 New Low Incidence Apportionment Distribution Model

Dr. Jean Martin shared information about the new low incidence apportionment. The NOC SELPA will receive approximately \$741,881. On September 16, 2020, the NOC SELPA Directors and Business Officials (DBO) members reviewed twelve models for distribution and collaboratively agreed to distribute funds to districts based on current ADA. The SELPA office would receive \$1,803 to provide funds for low incidence expenses. Special Schools would not receive an allocation due to the fact that the districts of residence are responsible for providing low incidence equipment to students placed in the Special School programs.

The low incidence funds can be used by the districts for equipment and services for students who have a low incidence disability, which includes hard of hearing, deaf, visual impairment, orthopedic impairment, and deaf-blindness.

Dr. Jeff Hittenberger initiated a motion to approve the NOC SELPA 2020-2021 New Low Incidence Apportionment Distribution Model. Dr. Scott Scambray seconded the motion.

5.0 Approval of the Distribution of Available Low Incidence Funds

Over the past several years, districts have submitted low incidence claims to the NOC SELPA for reimbursement. The claims have been fully funded. Upon review of the low incidence fund balance, it was noted that there is \$318,056 available in the low incidence budget. On September 16, 2020, the NOC SELPA Directors and Business Officials agreed to allocate the available funds based on current ADA. The funds will be metered out over three years at a flat amount to minimize the impact on the Maintenance of Effort (MOE).

The low incidence funds can be used by the districts for equipment and services for students who have a low incidence disability, which includes hard of hearing, deaf, visual impairment, orthopedic impairment, and deaf-blindness.

6.0 Approval of the North Orange County Special Education Local Plan Area Participation in the Parent Infant Education and Support (PIES) Program Income Agreement

The NOC SELPA and the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) collaborate to provide a comprehensive system of educational support to infants with disabilities and their parents throughout Orange County. The funding for this program is provided by a grant from the California Department of Education (Part C). The Infant program is a required component in the continuum of services to individuals with exceptional needs and has been in operation since 1995.

At present, the NOC SELPA has twelve infants enrolled in the PIES program. Infants and their families are served in a center-based and in-home model through the OCDE. The total infant population in the PIES program fluctuates throughout the year. This agreement between the OCDE and the NOC SELPA allows the PIES program to continue serving this pupil population and their families within our SELPA.

9.0 Aligning the North Orange County Special Education Local Plan Area Mental Health Guidance with SB 820

Dr. Jean Martin shared the conversations that the NOC SELPA Directors and Business Officials had regarding aligning the NOC SELPA Mental Health Guidance with Senate Bill (SB) 820. Currently, the NOC SELPA districts use the State mental health funds exclusively for students with IEPs. SB 820 allows districts to use the funds for both general education and special education students. To date, the NOC SELPA Directors and Business Officials would prefer to continue utilizing the State mental health funds for students on IEPs.

10.0 Alternative Dispute Resolution Grant

Dr. Jean Martin shared that the NOC SELPA applied for an Alternative Dispute Resolution Grant. The Grant award will be based on the number of SELPAs that applied for the Grant. It is anticipated that the NOC SELPA will receive approximately \$70,000. The Grant award will be used to fund Facilitated IEP Trainings by Key2Ed.

11.0 Update on the IDEA Class Action Lawsuits

Dr. Jean Martin provided an update on the *Martinez et al. v. Newsom et al.* and the *J.T. et al. v. deBlasio et al.* class action lawsuits.
